CITY OF MCCOOK RECREATIONAL/SWIMMING POOL SURVEY

The City of McCook has recently completed a swimming pool assessment, to determine the condition of the existing swimming pool. The original pool and bathhouse were built in 1937 as a WPA project. In 1965, a 105' x 50' section was added to the east of the original pool. In 2002-2003, a renovation project was completed on the pool. This project included improvements to the concrete deck, pool plumbing, filter room plumbing, crack repair, pool painting and improvements to the bathhouse. The following deficiencies were found during the swimming pool assessment:

- a. Recirculation system is not adequate to meet current standards and regulations.
- b. The rapid sand filter troughs are deteriorating.
- c. Deck equipment is old and needs to be replaced with modern equipment.
- d. Pools do not comply with current American Disabilities Act(ADA) requirements.
- e. Pool walls and floors have crevices and holes.
- f. Bathhouse doors on pool side need to be replaced. (Doors have been ordered and will be replaced soon).
- g. Flooding of deck between bathhouse and medium pool.
- h. Cracks in bathhouse blocks.
- i. Bathhouse does not comply with current ADA requirements.
- j. ADA parking spaces are required.(City to establish ADA parking stall(s)).

Preliminary engineer's opinion of probable construction cost to address the above referenced deficiencies on the existing pool is \$948,000.00.

Preliminary engineer's opinion of probable construction cost to build a new swimming pool and bathhouse of equal size is \$4,897,500.00.

Preliminary engineer's opinion of probable construction cost to build a new swimming pool and bathhouse of an alternate smaller size is \$3,640,000.00.

In order to move forward with any aquatic improvements in the City of McCook, the City would like your input as to what you would like to see in your municipal swimming pool.
